

International Guidelines increasingly recommend acupuncture!

As the Austrian Acupuncture Society (ÖGA) celebrates its 70th anniversary, we are pleased to highlight the worldwide growing recognition of the importance of acupuncture. The NICE (National Institute for Health and Care Excellence) Guidelines in the UK recommends acupuncture for the treatment of chronic primary pain. The American Society of Clinical Oncology included acupuncture into its guidelines for treatment of patients experiencing aromatase-inhibitor related pain in breast cancer and also for general pain and musculoskeletal pain from cancer. The American College of Physicians recommends acupuncture for chronic low back pain and the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery for the treatment of allergic rhinitis. Australia's government-funded centralized health information service lists a dozen conditions for which evidence supports its use.

In acknowledgement of this growing recognition, ÖGA has invited some of the original authors responsible for contributing to this progress to our conference. Mike Cummings will come from UK and report on NICE Guidelines, Jun J Mao from Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, New York will talk about his experiences with breast cancer patients and the Guidelines of the American Society of Clinical Oncology. John Mc Donald will lecture on the Australian Acupuncture Evidence Project. Further international experts such as Benno Brinkhaus, Dominik Irnich, Moritz Hempen und Thomas Burgoon will discuss recent scientific findings in acupuncture research.

Acupuncture's inclusion in many official clinical guidelines is an important validation of acupuncture research and medical acupuncture practice. This body of guidelines and the science supporting them are a valuable resource of information for both the public and for all levels of healthcare practitioners.

A Round-Table discussion will be held to promote the exchange with health-policy makers and stakeholders, and to better incorporate acupuncture evidence into decision making within health systems.

This conference is organized as a continuous platform in cooperation with DÄGfA, ÖGA, SMS and the Czech Medical Acupuncture Society. The conference goal is to present up-to-date scientific developments in acupuncture research and to disseminate evidence on acupuncture. We hope that this informative conference will facilitate access to acupuncture and enable more patients to benefit from acupuncture therapy.

This congress will also present lectures and "hands-on" practical-clinical workshops to enable physicians to expand and deepen their knowledge.

We are looking forward to welcome you in Vienna!
